Worship

We gather to worship every Sunday at **10:45AM**.

Our service is a blend of the old and the new with traditional hymns on the organ and more modern tunes on the keyboard. We stand to sing and remain seated for prayer. Music is an important part of our ministry at St. Paul's.

As with most Presbyterian churches, the sermon plays a central role in our worship service because preaching both grows and preserves the faith.

Audio-visual aids are often incorporated into the message, enabling us to more clearly understand the word of God.



Activities

St. Paul's has an active **Church School** with a supervised **Nursery** and classes for children ranging in age from 4 to 14. Lessons are based on scripture stories and how they relate to daily life, but also include crafts, games and fun.



We host movie nights throughout the year for children and for adults. And there is a **Youth Group** that gets together for bowling nights, barbeques and pool parties.

A **Bible Study** is held in the Church every Thursday afternoon at 4PM and our **Choir** is always on the look-out for new members, especially if you are a tenor or a bass.

The **Women's Missionary Society** also meets monthly for prayer, study and fellowship.

Mission

Our congregation strongly believes in the idea of supporting groups and causes locally, nationally and internationally - wherever there's a need.

Over the years, St. Paul's has:

- Donated children's Bibles to CHEO;
- Assisted Gracefield Christian Camp and Retreat Centre;
- Helped with the construction of a student hostel in Jobat, India;
- Participated in The Samaritan's Purse Christmas Shoeboxes;
- Fundraised for disaster relief around the world;
- Supported health clinics in Gaza, and more.

On the first Sunday of every month, items are collected for the Salvation Army Food Bank. The children also organize a special Thanksgiving collection of school lunch items that are also distributed throughout North Grenville, where there is a need.
